

Triphylla Type Fuchsia Varieties

Abbreviations: T - Tube S - Sepals C - Corolla or Petals * Interspecific Hybrid

- ADINDA** (Dijkstra 1995) T - salmon. S - lighter shade of salmon. C - salmon. Foliage sage green. Upright and self branching.
- BESSIE KIMBERLEY** (Kimberley 2001) T, S & C - scarlet red. Dark foliage. Ideal for small pot class.
- BILLY GREEN** (British 1966) T - pinkish salmon and long. S & C - pinkish salmon. Olive green foliage.
- BORNEMANN'S BESTE** (Bonstedt) T, S & C - orange-red. Strong growing. Terminal flowering.
- BOY MARC** (Stannard 1995) T, S & C - orange. Compact plant with long lasting flowers.
- BRIAN C. MORRISON** (Stannard 1993) T & S - rose red. C - bright orange. Upright.
- BRIAN KIMBERLEY** (Goulding 1999) T, S & C - pale orange. Upright. Good show plant.
- CATHARINA** T & S - red. C - dark red. Dark reddish brown foliage. Growth upright.
- CHANTRY PARK** (Stannard 1993) T & S - orangey red. C - bright scarlet. Suitable for baskets and hanging pots. Terminal flowering.
- CHRISTMAS GEM*** (German - date unknown) Hybrid of *F. triphylla* x *F. serratafolia* T & S - reddish vermilion. C - orange. Compact plant.
- CORNELIA SMITH** (Smits 1995) T & S - pinky red. C - deeper pinky red.
- DORRIAN BROGDALE** (Goulding 1994) T & S - pink with orange. C - pink overlaid with orange. Lax growth. Terminal flowering.
- ELFRIEDE OTT** (Nutziger 1976) T, S & C - salmon pink.
- FABIAN FRANCK** (Franck 1991) T & S - rose. C - orange. Bushy upright.
- FLOGMAN** (Netherlands 2006) T, S & C - redish orange. Upright.
- FREDERICK WOODWARD** (Kimberley 2005) T - white. S - white with red tips. C - pinky red. Strong upright growth. Will make a large plant.
- FUCHSIARAMA 91** (Stannard 1991) T, S & C - pink. Vigorous upright growth.
- GARTENMEISTER BONSTEDT** (Bonstedt 1905) T, S & C - orange brick-red. Dark bronzy-red foliage.
- GOLDEN ARROW** (Goulding 1985) T - orange, long and thin. S - green. C - tangerine. Trailing growth. Terminal flowering.
- HIROSHIGE** (Bogemann 1992) T & S - dark red. C - magenta. Makes a large upright bush.
- INSULINDE** (de Graaff 1991) T & S - red orange. C - dark orange. Bronzed green foliage. Bushy upright. Terminal flowering.
- JAP VAN'T VEER** (Smits 1994) T, S & C - pinky red. Sturdy upright growth. Terminal flowering.
- JILL HOLLOWAY** (Kimberley 2006) T & S - dark pink. C - red. Growth strong and spreading. Good for baskets.
- JOHN MAYNARD SCALES** (Goulding 1985) T, S & C - clear orange. Large sage green foliage. Strong upright growth. Terminal flowering.

KORALLE * (Bonstedt 1905) (*F. triphylla* x *F. fulgens*) T, S & C - salmon orange. Long tube and short petals. Foliage deep sage green.

LARK (Goulding) T&S = light orange C - orange Lax growth.

LEE ANTHONY (Goulding 1994) T - light pink. S - white. C - pinky red

LEN BIELBY (Oxtoby 1987) T - scarlet. S - currant red. C - mandarin red. Upright and vigorous.

LESLEY (Howard 1966) T, S & C - dark pink. Flowers have a waxy texture.

LEVERKUSEN (Rehnelt 1928) T, S & C - rosy cerise. Free flowering.

LONG DISTANCE (de Cooker 1993) T & S - red. C - light rose red. Long flowers.

MANTILLA (Reiter 1948) T, S & C - deep carmine. Natural trailer.

MARY * (Bonstedt 1894) (*F. triphylla* x *F. boliviana*) T, S & C - brilliant scarlet red. Foliage dark green with reddish purple veins.

MONICA DARE (Goulding 1999) T & S - bright orange. C - brownish orange. Growth upright and self branching. For medium sized pots.

ROOS BREYTENBACH (Stannard 1993) T & S - pinky red. C - orangey red. Terminal flowering.

SPARKY (Webb 1994) T, S & C - very dark red with yellow green tips. Flowers small and cylindrical in shape. Foliage very dark green. Short jointed

STELLA ANN (Baker-Dunnett 1974) T - poppy red. S - coral tipped green. C - Indian orange. Foliage olive green with red veins.

STONEHENGE (Koerts Tielko G 2012) T&S - dark rose C - red. Upright.

THALIA (Turner 1855) T, S & C - rich orange scarlet. Foliage olive green veined magenta. Upright,. Terminal flowering.

TIMOTHY TITUS (Goulding 1998) T & S - dusky orange. C - orange with a hint of brown. Growth sturdy and upright. Self branching.

TRAUDCHEN BONSTEDT * (Bonstedt 1905) (*F. triphylla* x *F. fulgens*) T, S & C - creamy pale salmon. Light green foliage. Terminal flowering.

TRUMPETER (Reiter 1946) T, S & C - pale geranium lake. Long flowers in clusters. Foliage bluish green. Makes an excellent basket.
